The City of Houston is providing an initial supply of vaccine to TWU transportation and maintenance workers.

Vaccines will be scheduled and given in keeping with CDC guidelines. Transportation and maintenance workers 65+, and those with chronic conditions, are eligible for a vaccine.

Chronic conditions include:

- Type 2 Diabetes
- Heart Disease
- COPD
- High Blood Pressure
- Kidney Disease
- Cancer
- Pregnancy
- Obesity
- Sickle Cell
- Smokers
